Philippe Starck was born on January 18, 1949, in Paris. The son of André Starck, an aeronautical engineer, he says that his father, also an engineer, often inspired him, considering invention a duty. His family was originally from Alsace, where they lived until his grandfather moved to Paris. He studied at the École Camondo in Paris. Philippe Starck, Hot Bertaa Kettle, 1987. Alessi. Part of the design collection of the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA) in New York. Limited edition. Mirror-polished finish. The longer part of this tube serves as the handle, the shorter as the spout. The kettle is filled by slowly pouring water through the spout. As it heats, steam escapes through this opening, creating the illusion of movement.
