Its circular top with generously rounded edges rests on three substantial cylindrical legs, striking a balance between primitivism and modernity that has lost none of its power. The solid oak, with its wide grain patinated by decades of use, reveals warm, golden tones of beautiful depth, enhanced by meticulous craftsmanship in the Maison Lecan workshops. With its 91 cm diameter and low 37 cm height, this table naturally commands attention in the center of a living room, whether in a minimalist contemporary interior or a space
