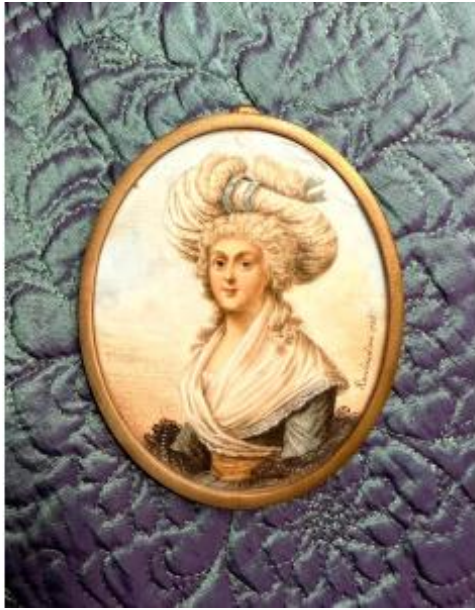

With her hair styled in a Turkish fashion, this charming portrait, commissioned from the renowned English painter favored by the nobility, portrays the beautiful and proud Countess of Worcesler against a blue sky in her park. She gazes directly at the viewer, holding her pose in her elegant attire: a wide white silk collar with a scalloped edge, and a light blue silk dress cinched at the waist with gold silk. Her extravagant headdress sits atop her beautiful powdered hair, which cascades down the sides. A museum-quality piece, historically significant and of known provenance, it is signed and dated lower right by the artist. In perfect condition, this beautiful
