Description

Pair of decorative panels, overdoors with winged cherub heads. Italy, 19th century. Elegant pair of decorative panels in finely carved and gilded wood, embellished at the center with sculptural winged cherub heads carved in high relief. The angelic figures, characterized by delicate, childlike features and outstretched wings, emerge from a rich ornamental design composed of scrolls and vegetal motifs in the late Baroque style. The gilding, applied in leaf style on a polychrome base with a green background, creates a refined chromatic contrast that enhances the depth of the carving and the quality of the sculptural modeling. The rendering of the faces and plumage reveals the hand of a skilled carver and reflects the decorative language widespread in 19th-century Italian furniture, inspired by

Baroque and Rococo models. Due to their typology and structure, these elements were likely intended to surmount important furnishings, mirrors, overdoors, or wainscoting elements, fulfilling an ornamental function with a striking visual impact. The back shows the original support structure and fixing points. The surface retains a remarkably charming antique patina, with slight wear to the gilding consistent with the work's age, testifying to its authenticity and history. These objects of great decorative quality are ideal for enhancing elegant spaces.
