A pair of platinum drop earrings (hallmarked with a mascaron head), reminiscent of sleeper earrings. They are adorned with old cushion-cut diamonds set in settings that give them a visually perfectly round shape. These stones, sourced from some of the oldest jewelry, offer absolutely incomparable brilliance and vibrancy. Two diamonds are set as studs on the ear, mounted on posts for pierced ears fitted with secure Alpas clasps. These clasps are made of 18k white gold (750/°°). Two larger diamonds are suspended from these studs, a suspension that gives them great mobility and allows them to capture the light and fully reveal their brilliance. The diamonds are of a good size, measuring 6.1 to 6.3 mm for the top ones and 7.1 to 7.3 mm for the suspended stones. A must-have earring, featuring stones of rare vibrancy.
