Description

This painting is an oil on cardboard. It is presented in an antique molded wooden frame with a light patina. It is dated 1928. It is a portrait of a woman, seen in three-quarter view. Her gaze is turned to the side, in a pensive and melancholic pose. Her face, rendered with soft and expressive brushstrokes, is illuminated by a gentle light that highlights her features. She wears a dark garment, probably a black dress, covered by a shawl in warm hues--reds, oranges, and ochres--whose patterns and brushstrokes provide contrast to the composition. Her brown hair is styled in a simple chignon. The palette is dominated by earthy and natural tones (beige, brown, ochre), typical of many early 20th-century European portraits. The neutral, slightly textured background emphasizes the central figure. The brushstrokes are visible,
