Description

A remarkable Art Deco cabinet attributed to the renowned Belgian firm De Coene Frères, crafted in the 1930s, embodies the refined luxury and architectural elegance that characterized the firm's work during the interwar period. This impressive piece combines sculptural forms, exceptional materials, and meticulous craftsmanship--hallmarks of De Coene's major contribution to European Art Deco design. The cabinet features a harmonious façade, with a central mirrored section framed by a richly veined marble top, flanked by two tall side compartments. The curved lines, symmetrical composition, and subtle interplay of convex and concave surfaces reflect the sophisticated geometry characteristic of Belgian Art Deco. Turned legs elevate the piece slightly, lending it
