Description

View of the Portal of the Seminario Arcivescovile in Milan (now Portrait Milano), 1898. Oil on canvas, signed and dated lower left: Negroni, 1898. This charming Milanese veduta depicts the monumental portal of the former Archbishop's Seminary of Milan, now part of the prestigious Hotel Portrait Milano, in Milan's historic center. The artist chose to represent the Baroque doorway that marks the entrance to the vast religious complex founded in the 16th century. The richly sculpted portal is flanked by two imposing telamones supporting the architecture. Above the arch unfolds a triangular pediment adorned with reliefs, surmounted by an ecclesiastical coat of arms, recalling the religious function of the place. The half-open door reveals the perspective of an inner courtyard and the

seminary buildings, while a few elegant figures enliven the scene and situate the composition within the peaceful atmosphere of late 19th-century Milan. With its intimate scale and precise treatment of the architecture, this work belongs to the tradition of Italian urban vedute, highly prized by travelers and collectors during the Belle Époque. Today, it stands as a charming testament to the historical character of this Milanese neighborhood, well before the transformations of the 20th century.
