An elegant pair of Bertoia Wire Chairs, designed by Harry Bertoia and produced by Knoll International. Created in 1952, this icon of modernist design is distinguished by its structure of welded steel wires forming a delicate and graphic grid, resting on a characteristic wire base. Harry Bertoia himself described his creations as true "functional sculptures," where the transparency of the metal plays with space and light. This pair was acquired in the 1970s from Knoll International, attesting to an authentic production from the second half of the 20th century. The chairs feature the classic form of the model: a slightly curved shell ensuring comfort and support, a chromed steel frame, and a stable four-legged base. Highly sought after by 20th-century design enthusiasts, they fit equally
