Description

An elegant patinated bronze candlestick from the late 19th century depicting an upright serpent. The animal is shown coiled at the base, its body unfurling vertically in a sinuous movement to support the candle holder. The sculpting is particularly refined: the reptile's scales are finely chiseled, and the curve of its body creates a dynamic and decorative silhouette. The serpent's upright and stylized head forms a transition to a gadrooned candle holder with classical decoration. This type of object, blending naturalism and decorative taste, is characteristic of the production of objets d'art from the second half of the 19th century, reflecting the spirit of the decorative arts of the period, where animal and exotic motifs were particularly popular. The bronze has a beautiful antique patina. Period: late
