Description

Oil on canvas. Original canvas. Signed on the front and on the frame. Under the harsh light of a hyperrealism that leaves nothing to chance, not even the tiniest crack in the wood, this green-paned window stands, guardian of everyday inertia. The paint, flaking and patinated by decades of sun and dust, reveals a texture so tactile that one can almost smell the old varnish and the dampness of the Castilian countryside. It is the apotheosis of the mundane, a surface that asserts itself in its rustic materiality to convince us that the world is nothing but wood, nails, and shadow. Yet, the absence of one of its panes shatters this semblance of normality; through a technical mesh, almost invisible but impenetrable, the gaze is drawn into an infinite red space that defies all physical logic. It is not a room that one

glimpses, but an abyssal, monochrome depth that vibrates with absolute chromatic intensity, as if the canvas had been wounded to reveal the blood of the universe. This fracture in the domestic sphere functions as one of the gateways to perception that Huxley spoke of, suggesting that reality is but a poorly fitted seam covering an abyss of unbearable intensity. The unusual here does not arise from the fantastic, but from the terrifying proximity between the infinitesimal and the eternal: the brutal transition between the splinters of wood and the immensity of a red that ignores horizon and perspective. It is the sublime concealed behind the veil of the ordinary, a metaphysical reminder that any common object, however humble or rudimentary, can be the threshold of a dimension that reason cannot grasp. The viewer is thus suspended in an existential vertigo, trapped between the security of the rustic and the hypnotic call of an infinity that observes us from the other side of a simple village window.- Image dimensions without frame: 53 x 64 cm / 68 x 78.5 cm with exclusive custom frame.
