Félix Planquette, born in Arras on April 23, 1873, and died in Paris on March 12, 1964, was a French landscape and animal painter. In the Manche region, which he explored from the Bay of Mont-Michel to the cliffs of La Hague, this talented painter delivers a realistic and colorful style. La Hague is a region located in the Manche department of Normandy, more precisely in the Cotentin peninsula. It is known for its spectacular landscapes shaped by the sea. Like the famous northern cliffs of the Cotentin peninsula painted by Jean-François Millet, a native of the region, La Hague boasts some of the most beautiful natural areas in the Cotentin.
