



Iron Tsuba With Vegetal Decoration In Zogan Style - Early Edo Period (17th-19th Century)

Description

A circular iron tsuba (maru-gata) with applied brass inlay (zogan) depicting stylized and herbaceous plant motifs. The design extends to the rim and onto raised areas that break the circularity of the tabletop, creating a dynamic and asymmetrical effect. The iron has an old, dark brown patina. The inlays, partially worn, indicate traditional production intended for practical use. This piece is attributable to the Heianjo Zogan tradition (Kyoto). Wear and partial losses of inlay are consistent with age.
