Daitsuki-niju-habaki in copper covered with silver, chiselled with a bamboo fence motif. Saya in wood covered with black fluted lacquer. Silver kojiri, depicting a chrysanthemum. Kuri gata and koi guchi in lacquered buffalo horn. Wooden tsuka ito, covered with shagreen, braided with green silk and brass thread. Menuki depicting two figures in brass covered with brass. Kashira in silver-covered brass, chiselled with a chrysanthemum. Fuchi decorated in suite. Tsuba
