Description

Armenian Engraved Copper Candlestick - Ottoman Empire, circa 1801. Description: Turned copper candlestick with a baluster stem and wide circular base, intended for liturgical or domestic religious use. The base bears an engraved Armenian inscription, likely indicating a votive dedication and a date corresponding to the very beginning of the 19th century (circa 1801). This is an example of Armenian craftsmanship from the Ottoman period, characteristic of the production of Christian communities in Anatolia and the Caucasus, where religious objects were often signed or dedicated. Condition: Beautiful antique patina, with age-appropriate signs of use and oxidation. No visible restoration. This object is historically significant due to the presence of the Armenian inscription.
