Description

- Marble. Signed and dated. - Athanase Apartis, an emblematic figure of modern Hellenic sculpture, forged a unique artistic identity amidst the vibrant Parisian scene of the Roaring Twenties. A devoted disciple of Antoine Bourdelle, he integrated himself into the intellectual and artistic circles of Montparnasse, where he mingled with the avant-garde while remaining faithful to a formal rigor inherited from classical tradition. 1928 was a pivotal year for Apartis: firmly established in the Parisian art scene, he exhibited his works at the prestigious Salon des Tuileries and the Salon d'Automne, demonstrating his mastery of portraiture and monumental figures. It was during this period that he deepened his research on the synthesis between Greek archaism and Bourdelle's
