The seat rail and uprights are adorned with fine decorative marquetry, of great delicacy of execution, which elegantly highlights the lines of the furniture. The set features rosewood with a rich, deep grain, enhanced by a high-quality French polish that gives the wood remarkable depth and shine. The armchairs rest on exquisitely cabriole legs, perfectly balanced in
