A magnificent example of early Belgian industrial craftsmanship, this solid oak workbench, dating from around 1900, bears the unmistakable mark of a century-old workshop. Built to last and withstand intensive daily use, it boasts a rich, textured patina, a testament to decades of service. Every mark, every stain, every worn edge tells a part of its story. Made from thick, heavy oak planks, the workbench rests on sturdy legs, reinforced with cross braces for optimal stability. A traditional vise is still attached to the side, its handle and metal fittings displaying the authentic marks of a long life. The worktop is deeply patinated, with tool marks, traces of paint, and an irregular texture of striking beauty, the result of time and skilled craftsmanship. At the turn of the 20th century,
