Description

A refined and superbly executed example of French Art Deco design, this 1925 side table combines elegant geometry with ingenious functionality. Its octagonal top and stepped base lend it a strong architectural presence, while the rich burl veneer adds warmth, depth, and the characteristic luxury of the era. The table features two discreet drawers, each designed for a specific purpose: one houses a metal ashtray--complete with a cigarette rest--reflecting the social rituals of the 1920s, and the other is compartmentalized for small personal items. These thoughtful details speak to the era's fascination with built-in utility and the refinement of everyday life. Recently professionally restored, the burl veneer now reveals its full complexity and shimmering grain, while the metal elements retain their vintage
