Grand Imperial Meiji Japan burns perfume (1868-1912) decorated in traditional costume characters finely painted and highlighted with gold, geisha and samurai. Both side grips the vessel and that of the perforated dome cover are shaped Fo dogs. Or rather, for the Japanese, guardian lion Komainu symbol of wealth or social statue .Traditionnellement high in the imperial palace representative supremacy over the world. The vase rests on three feet out of the chimera of mouth .A note 2 feet formerly glued (invisible) and the use of wear of the gilding on the projections of the room ...
