Description

Antique silver cutlery set comprising a spoon and fork, violin pattern, typical of the late 18th and early 19th centuries. The pieces bear several hallmarks: o Rooster hallmark (1798-1809) guaranteeing solid silver, o Number 61 corresponding to the Marseille assay office, o Goldsmith's lozenge-shaped hallmark, o Laureate head hallmark (1819-1838) attesting to a subsequent re-inspection of the silverware. An old engraving on the back: P ? R / D o A o P, probably a family or marriage monogram. Beautiful typology from the Directoire/Consulate - early Empire period, with an elongated spoon and a fork with fine tines. A fine example of antique French silverware, probably from Provence (Marseille). For any questions, please call 0778337598
