Description

Monumental format - Absolutely pristine condition - Museum-quality piece. An impressive hard-paste porcelain figurative group, modeled with the virtuosity characteristic of the Volkstedt workshops in the 19th century. The scene depicts an elegant woman standing, dressed in a magenta bodice and a skirt with yellow floral decoration, accompanied by a young child holding a horn and draped in white with a red ribbon. The modeling of the flesh, the delicacy of the fingers, the vibrancy of the fabrics, and the precision of the floral garlands testify to first-rate craftsmanship. The richly openwork rocaille base is adorned with gilded scrolls, floral cartouches, and polychrome highlights of exceptional freshness. The reverse reveals equally meticulous craftsmanship: the tree trunk, foliage, and drapery are rendered with the

same precision as the front, confirming a piece designed to be displayed in the round, in an aristocratic interior or a collector's showcase.
