Description

Dimensions: Height 14.5 cm; Total length (including handles) 14.5 cm. An elegant, mouth-blown crystal bonbonnière in a deep violet hue, mounted in a finely chased bronze frame. The piece is distinguished by the purity of its crystal, whose faceted base unmistakably reveals entirely handmade craftsmanship, characteristic of refined 19th-century production. The generously proportioned body is enhanced by an openwork mount decorated with scrolls, stylized foliage, and volutes, perfectly following the curves of the crystal. Two symmetrical, richly molded side handles lend the whole a harmonious and majestic silhouette. The lid, surmounted by a faceted crystal finial, completes the piece's balance and captures the light with a subtle brilliance. The piece demonstrates virtuoso

craftsmanship, combining the delicacy of blown glass with the ornamental rigor of chased bronze. A rare collector's item, both for its state of preservation and the quality of its execution, it is representative of French decorative taste in the second half of the 19th century. This particular example is distinguished by its exceptional state of preservation, without any cracks or restorations, a quality that has become uncommon for this type of object. It constitutes a refined testament to French decorative taste in the second half of the 19th century, ideal for a discerning collection.
