Important Carrara marble sculpture depicting Esmeralda with her goat Djali, a character from the celebrated novel *Notre-Dame de Paris* by Victor Hugo. Executed in 1860, the sculpture demonstrates the artist's refined technical mastery and Romantic sensibility. The composition is distinguished by the careful treatment of drapery, the expressive figure, and the naturalistic depiction of the animal. The engraved signature on the base is key for authentication and reads: "PROre G.PE LAZZERINI di CARRARA FECE 1860." A sculpture of strong visual presence and significant historical and collectible interest. Material: Carrara marble Dimensions: Height 120 cm - Width 100 cm - Depth 70 cm.
