Description

An impressive, monumental gilt-bronze centerpiece of exceptional quality, attributed to Christofle & Cie, Paris, dating from the late 19th century. The composition features two finely sculpted putti positioned on either side of the base, each elegantly supporting the central basket. The figures carry floral garlands on their shoulders, lending the piece a classical character that is both graceful and full of vivacity. The openwork basket is richly decorated with finely chased ornaments, including interlaced borders, beaded moldings, and scrolling motifs. The handles take the elegant form of rams' heads, while the molded base rests on splayed feet and is centered with a monogram medallion. The remarkable quality of the chasing and the richness of the gilding testify to the high level of
