A charming slipware pitcher depicting a rooster, decorated in vibrant polychrome. The body is adorned with a cartouche bearing the inscription "Le Gaulois" (The Gaul), with a naturalistic relief of foliage. The spout is formed by the rooster's head, and the handle represents its stylized tail. A French decorative piece from the late 19th or early 20th century, typical of slipware pottery. No chips, very good overall condition.
