The lost wax cast, chiseled and gilded bronze handles add a touch of luxury and refinement to the furniture. The stone top veneered in yellow Siena marble with brown veins and finished with an owl's beak is a valuable detail that gives further elegance and uniqueness to the chest of drawers.
