A cherrywood standing man table, typical of the Louis XV style, offering a refined and welcoming presence. This regional piece is distinguished by its molded cornice and delicate marquetry of a compass rose on the upper rail, a rare detail that signifies meticulous craftsmanship. The front features a single door, mounted on large original hinges, adorned with a panel of flowing moldings. The long, finely crafted brass escutcheon comes with its key and a working lock, adding to the authentic charm of the piece. The functional interior opens to reveal a storage space with three adjustable shelves on racks, allowing the table to be adapted for various uses: linens, dishes, books, or personal items. The carved and scrolled lower rail is supported by Louis XV snail feet, adding a touch of lightness
