Description

A set of three antique bronze medals, likely 19th century. One medal reproduces the royal seal of Philip IV the Fair, with the Latin inscription PHILIPPVS DEI GRATIA FRANCORVM REX, depicting the king seated on his throne. Another medal features a female allegory surrounded by symbols related to commerce, industry, and economic activity. The third medal is an allegorical representation of Victory on a triumphal chariot, with winged Victory and mythological figures, signed by the engraver William Barre.
