Description

A decorative cast pewter plaque depicting a mythological marine scene (thiasos) with Neptune, nymphs, tritons, and cupids moving among the waves. The rich relief is inspired by classical iconography, in the neoclassical style. The piece is made of solid pewter, with a raw, cast reverse and a central mounting hole, indicating former use on furniture, a box, or a decorative element. Likely made in the late 19th or early 20th century (circa 1880-1910). An antique decorative art object representing a mythological marine procession.
