A very beautiful and heavy solid silver sugar sifter spoon. The spoon is entirely in keeping with 18th-century production. It features a rimmed design in plain silver. The bowl is delicately pierced. The spoon is hallmarked: First rooster hallmark for Parisian solid silver, used between 1798 and 1809. Old man's head guarantee hallmark, for the same period. Maker's mark to be identified: OBD (?) with a privy mark composed of three elements, including a crescent. A very beautiful early spoon, still in the 18th-century style. It is particularly heavy, a sign of the quality of its craftsmanship. 21 cm long 99.7 grams. Good condition. Minor wear consistent with age. Collection in Paris or shipping via insured Colissimo.
