Two solid silver dessert spoons by Puiforcat, Iris pattern. This Iris pattern is one of the most famous and sought-after by Puiforcat, renowned for its refinement and exemplary Art Nouveau style. The spatulas and stems are decorated with iris flowers and leaves forming ribbons that intertwine to enliven the handles. The handles terminate in a magnificent bouquet of irises that cascade down the bowls. The spatulas are engraved with different numbers: "Ad'E" & "PL" (?). Each piece is hallmarked: . EP with a penknife for Puiforcat. Minerva hallmark, 1st standard, pre-1973, for 950/1000 silver. Superb pair of spoons, one of the most beautiful and sought-after Art Nouveau designs, by one of the greatest silversmiths of the period. 18.8 cm 104.5 grams total weight. Very good condition.
