These objects were used in churches to hold blessed palm branches, particularly during Palm Sunday, or other vegetal elements used in liturgical celebrations. They feature an elegant vase-shaped body raised on a circular foot, with refined fluted decorations on the upper part and at the base. The wooden core covered with silvered metal is a typical construction technique used in ecclesiastical objects of the period, allowing for both solidity and lightness. The surface shows a natural patina consistent with age, with traces of liturgical use that attest to their authenticity. Sold as a set of five pieces.
