Description

Elegant sculpture depicting the Virgin Mary, produced in the 1950s by the C.I.A. Manna manufactory in Turin, known for its artistic ceramic sculptures and decorative works of the 20th century. The figure is modeled with refined delicacy and shows a gentle and contemplative expression, typical of mid-century devotional statuary. The flowing drapery gives the sculpture balance and decorative presence. The C.I.A. Manna workshop was founded in Turin in the 1930s by ceramists connected to the artistic circle of the famous Lenci factory and became known for high-quality ceramic sculptures.
