CHRISTOFLE Important Silvered Bronze and Cut Crystal Centerpiece Paris, late 19th century
An elegant neoclassical-inspired centerpiece composed of a large cut crystal bowl decorated with gadroons, resting on a finely chased silvered bronze mount. The stem, richly adorned with acanthus leaves and classical motifs, rises above an openwork circular base decorated with a Greek key frieze and vegetal garlands, demonstrating particularly meticulous goldsmithing. The four-legged base, formed of scrolled feet embellished with stylized foliage, lends the whole piece balance and decorative presence.
