Description

Magnificent deep bowl in solid silver and enamel. The bowl was entirely hand-hammered using traditional techniques and retains the marks of this craftsmanship, which catch the light beautifully. The rim is decorated with a corded frieze. The center of the bowl features an applied central boss with a magnificent, large cloisonné enamel motif, typical of the Russian silversmithing tradition. The bowl is hallmarked on the reverse: 935 for the silver content 339 (?) likely a mint mark. The absence of any hallmarks other than the silver content makes identification difficult, although the central motif is typical of Russian enamel production. It is probably a 20th-century piece made in Russia or a country within the Russian cultural sphere of influence. The shape of this bowl, combined with
