Description

A charming Baroque cherub carved in wood, depicting a winged putto's head resting on a stylized cloud. The sculpture features an expressive face with rosy cheeks, abundant hair with deeply sculpted locks, and compact wings framing the face. The entire piece is polychrome and richly gilded, with a beautiful antique patina. The modeling of the face, the flowing hair, and the stylized form of the cloud are reminiscent of the decorative sculptures found on Baroque altarpieces in 18th-century Central Europe (Tyrol, Austria, or Bavaria), where such cherubs were used to enliven altar compositions. The reverse retains its original suspension ring, likely indicating that it was originally part of an architectural or religious setting. Highly decorative, this cherub would be a perfect
