A fine pair of gilt bronze baluster candlesticks decorated with palmettes and fleurons. The ogival base, adorned with arcades and fleurons on a matte background, supports the stem, which is chased with a fluted and gadrooned ring and fine beadwork. It terminates in a flared cyma molding supporting a palmette base, a foot, a socket, and a finely chased drip tray. The round base is decorated with palmettes and fleurons. The original mercury gilding is beautiful, with some minor wear consistent with age. Empire period. These candlesticks are attributable to the work of Claude Galle or Thomire.
