A set of four full-length portraits of 17th-century courtiers engraved by Henri Bonnard (1642-1711), also known as Henri II Bonnard, engraver and print dealer on Rue Saint-Jacques in Paris. The portraits include: Louis Joseph, Duke of Vendôme; Marshal de Montreuel; Marshal de Téssé; Marshal de Villeroy. The printed border reads: "In Paris at H.Bonnart's, Rue Saint-Jacques au Coq, with privilege." Presented as a pair in two separate frames, each with a 19th-century giltwood molding.
