Description

Léon Brunard (1872-1931) Glazed Stoneware Bowl/Vase - Circa 1920. This beautiful glazed stoneware ceramic piece was created by Léon Brunard, an artist and ceramist active in the early 20th century, whose work reflects the artistic revival of decorative arts between the two World Wars. The piece features a flared shape resting on a truncated conical foot, creating a very balanced and sculptural silhouette. The surface is covered with a nuanced glaze in shades of gray-green and blue, with beautiful natural drip effects characteristic of ceramic techniques from this period. The interior is decorated with a stylized frieze of repeated geometric motifs in darker shades, creating a delicate contrast with the light glaze. The piece demonstrates high-quality craftsmanship, where the material and firing

techniques contribute fully to its aesthetic appeal. The reverse bears the artist's mark, attesting to its authenticity. Léon Brunard's ceramics are sought after today for their formal modernity and their exploration of glazes, reflecting the dynamism of French ceramics in the 1920s. A very beautiful decorative piece, both understated and expressive, representative of the artist's work.
