"Virtue" Dagger - Twisted Marine Ivory Handle - 19th Century. This elegant "virtue" dagger features a straight, hexagonal blade ending in a tapered point. The hilt consists of a patinated metal guard with small lateral quillons, simple and well-balanced, typical of this type of civilian or symbolic weapon produced in the 19th century. The handle is carved from marine ivory, finely worked in a helical twist, offering a very comfortable grip and a particularly decorative aesthetic. The natural patina of the ivory testifies to the piece's age and gives it an authentic charm. This type of dagger, often called a "virtue dagger," belongs to the tradition of small civilian or ceremonial daggers, prized for their fine craftsmanship and symbolic character. The well-preserved blade displays a beautiful
