A striking pair of 18th century Portuguese cherub putti sculptures, each figure shown seated and holding both a cornucopia of abundance and an orb (world globe). These attributes symbolize prosperity, abundance, and the world, giving the pair a strong allegorical character. Beautifully modeled with expressive faces and lively movement, the figures reflect the decorative spirit of 18th century Baroque sculpture in Portugal. Their warm gilt surface and aged patina enhance the sculptural details and emphasize their historical character. The sculptures are presented on later black bases with metal supports, allowing them to be displayed elegantly while highlighting their dynamic forms. Putti with symbolic attributes were widely used in Portuguese Baroque decorative arts and ecclesiastical
