Description

René Bleuer (1896-1978) was a Swiss artist associated with the golden age of European poster design in the mid-20th century. He belongs to the renowned tradition of Swiss graphic designers who have left their mark on the history of advertising posters through their sense of composition, visual modernity, and graphic effectiveness. Primarily known for his lithographic advertising posters, Bleuer developed an elegant and concise style, characteristic of Art Deco aesthetics, where the stylization of forms, clarity of lines, and the use of bold colors play a central role. His work is part of the great tradition of 20th-century Swiss poster design, which helped make Switzerland one of the major centers of modern graphic design.
