Description

This painting depicts the rugged coastline of Cap Gris-Nez, on the Opal Coast in the Pas-de-Calais region. The composition is structured around a line of dark rocks that draws the eye towards the turbulent sea and the clear horizon. The foreground shows a sandy beach dotted with boulders and small pools of water reflecting the sky. The sky, rendered in broad strokes, is filled with luminous gray clouds, suggesting the ever-changing maritime atmosphere typical of the English Channel. The palette, dominated by muted tones - browns, grays, and greens - accentuates the impression of wind and humidity characteristic of this coastal landscape.
