Description

These armchairs, in the manner of Charles Dudouyt's work, were crafted in solid wood with woven rush seats and backs in France during the 1940s. They perfectly illustrate the mid-century rustic style, combining traditional woodworking techniques with simple, robust forms. The design is characterised by corkscrew-turned legs and front stretcher, a detail often associated with Dudouyt's sculptural style. Slightly curved armrests and a clean-lined structure give the chairs balanced proportions and an understated design, while the woven rush introduces a natural texture and tone that contrasts with the darker colour of the wood. Good overall condition with minor wear consistent with age and use. Recently polished. Seat height : 34 cm
