Tony Cardella (1898-1976) "The Port of Centuri in Corsica" Oil on canvas, Signed lower left, Titled on the reverse by the artist: "Centuri, Corsica", Exhibition label on the reverse. A beautiful, luminous, and high-contrast work by the Corsican painter, Tony Cardella, depicting a view of the port of Centuri in Corsica on a summer's day. In the foreground, one can distinguish the fishing boats hauled out at the quay. The background offers a general view of the fishing port. Attached to his roots, Tony Cardella never ceased, through his painting, to represent the landscapes of the Isle of Beauty and its inhabitants. His luminous and colorful palette perfectly captures the colors of the Mediterranean shores. In 1941, the artist completed admirable paintings for the interior of the Franciscan Church
