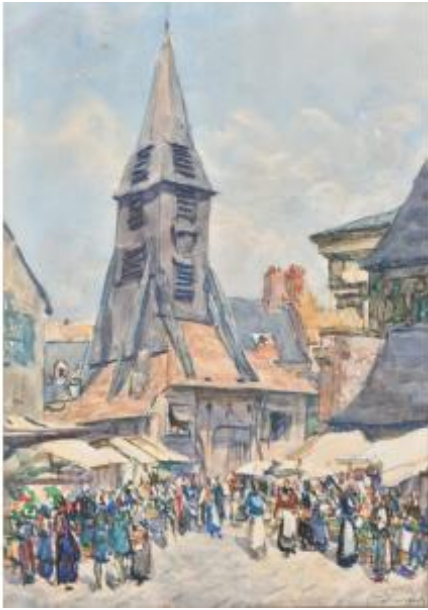




Fernand Fortuné Truffaut - Market In Front Of Sainte-catherine In Honfleur

Watercolor by Fernand Fortuné Truffaut depicting a market in front of the Church of Sainte-Catherine in Honfleur, 1908. Watercolor signed, located, and dated lower right. Artwork: 35 x 25 cm; frame: approximately 50 x 40 cm. Born in Trouville, Truffaut trained under the painters Auguste Alfred Rubé (1817-1899) and Eugène Chaperon (1857-1938). While this watercolor, executed in 1908, is unique in his oeuvre due to its lively nature, it also incorporates a typical architectural structure of the artist's style, with a composition featuring multiple planes. Original giltwood frame with a label bearing the artist's name.
