Description

Two remarkable 18th-century French pedestals, originating from a church, exemplify the sculptural presence and devotional character typical of ecclesiastical furnishings of the period. Each pedestal features a turned central column, its rounded shape reminiscent of a baluster, surmounting a flat top, ideal for displaying religious sculptures, candles, or liturgical objects. The tripod bases, with their gracefully curved feet, ensure stability while conveying a sense of movement and refinement. The wood displays a deep, patinated hue, a reflection of generations spent in a sacred space. As one might expect from pieces of this age, the pedestals bear the marks of
