JAPAN - MEIJI period (1868/1912) Round, gadrooned porcelain bowl with a crenellated rim, decorated in the IMARI style with a floral basket within a central rosette surrounded by floral reserves alternating with bands decorated in gold with flowers and foliage. Birds and flowers are depicted within reserves in the shape of lotus blossoms. 19th century. A small chip on one rim.
