Large Djimini mask, from the Senufo ethnic group. This enigmatic face appears to be surmounted by horns reminiscent of the Siginkuru-ayna buffalo mask. Beautiful patina, soft wood. Origin: Ivory Coast, Senufo ethnic group from the Dabakala region, estimated late 20th century. Dimensions: Height: 44 cm to 55 cm including the base - Width: 22 cm. The Senufo (or Siena, the name they give themselves, meaning those who speak Sene, the Senufo language) are an African ethnic group, present in Burkina Faso, southern Mali (mainly in the Sikasso region), and Ivory Coast (in the north, around the towns of Boundiali and Korhogo), numbering approximately 1.5 million members, or 9.7% of the Ivorian population.
